With my hands lifted to the heavens, I thank God for the privilege of serving him among international students and Muslims; locally and globally.



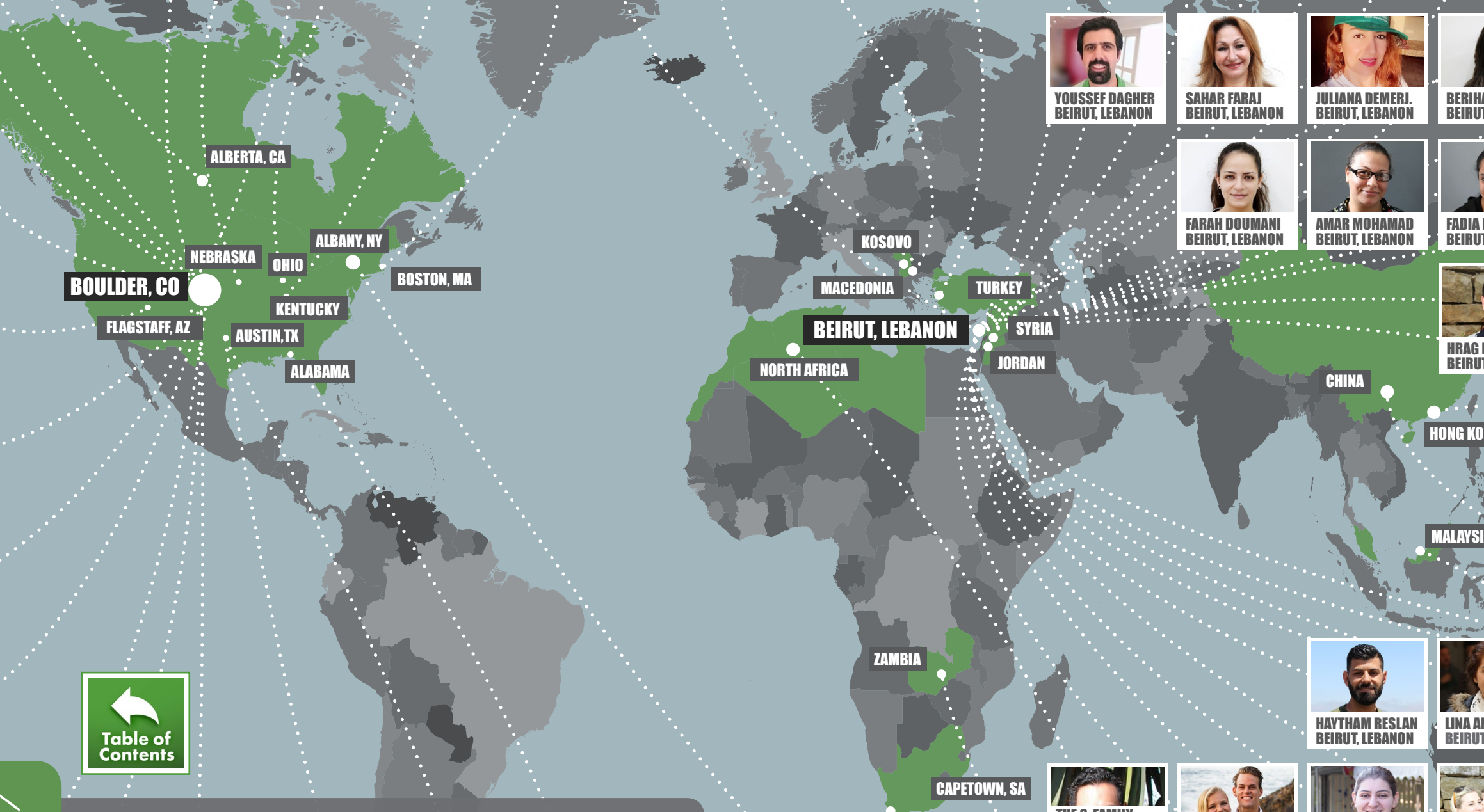
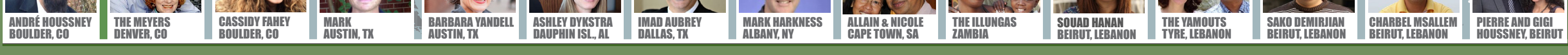
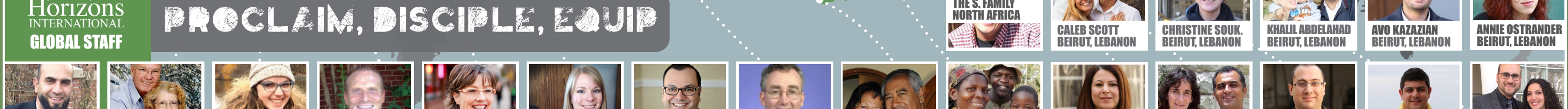
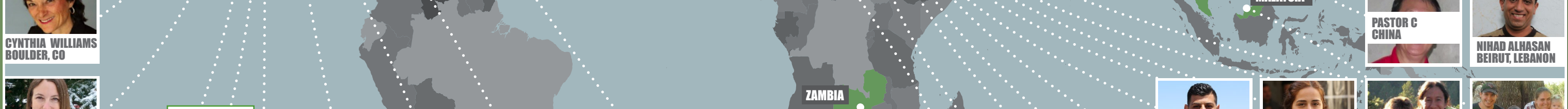
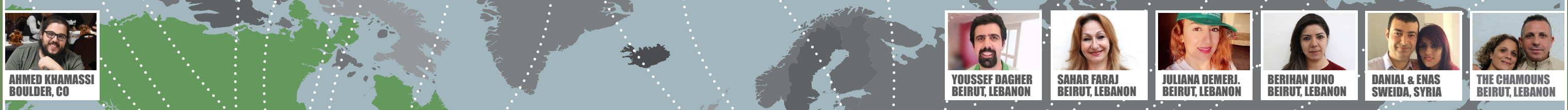

OUR CORE VALUES

1. Local and Global

Jesus gave us a mandate to be his witnesses in Jerusalem, Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth (Acts 1:8). In obedience, Horizons exists to proclaim the gospel, disciple the nations, and equip the church locally and globally – simultaneously. Every individual Christian and every local church must think and act globally.

2. Indigenous Church

We are committed to supporting, challenging, and equipping churches around the world to become mission sending bases. Our church empowerment program trains and equips each new church community to begin the process of sending missionaries. Church planting is most effective when indigenous churches reproduce themselves and multiply in their regions and beyond.

3. Boldness and Radical Faith

Today, many in the world missions community are gripped by crippling fears. The world needs the kind of fearless witness that we see in the New Testament. We promote open and bold proclamation of the gospel of salvation. (Ephesians 6:19-20) The powerful gospel cannot be expressed by secretive and indirect methods. Christ is worthy of our bold, loving, and courageous witness.

4. Organism over Organization

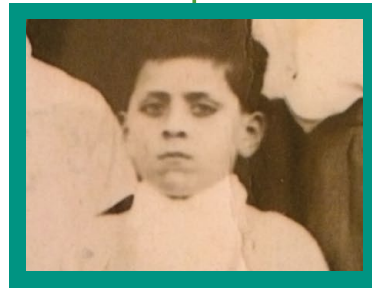
Today our churches and missions organizations too often operate like businesses or institutions. We strive to be a community, a living organism modeled after the church in the book of Acts. (I Corinthians 12:12) While every organism is highly organized, an organization without the element of organism is lifeless.

5. Biblical Faithfulness

Many unbiblical ideas and techniques are being propagated in the world of missions. Horizons is committed to ministering only in biblically faithful ways, and lovingly helping others to do likewise. We do this through various training programs and our website, biblicalmissiology.org. In doing so, we strive to maintain both unity and truth.

6. Kingdom Collaboration

Missions is all about the Kingdom of God. We strive to be Kingdom-minded, setting aside a competitive spirit to work alongside other people of the Kingdom – individuals, churches, and organizations – to promote God's global agenda, which is the gospel.



Georges Housney was born in a village in North Lebanon and raised in the nearby Muslim city of Tripoli. He became a born-again Christian in 1961, at a church newly planted by a Lebanese theology student from Beirut. During an evangelistic service, Georges felt the conviction of the Holy Spirit and jumped up in the middle of the sermon to surrender his life to Christ.

As he was being discipled in his local church, Georges began sharing his faith to family and friends. After a missionary challenged him to love Muslims as God does, Georges gained a heart, and a life-long calling, to reach Muslims. He evangelized abundantly throughout North Lebanon and was involved in several church plants, even running the services in 3 churches by the age of 16!

When Georges went to university in Beirut, he joined every student ministry he could find, and began taking mission trips around the Middle East and Europe. While working with a small campus community of believers reaching out to international students, he served alongside a young missionary woman named Jonelle "Joy" Reichert, whom he later married.

Fresh out of university, Georges got involved in Bible translation and spent 12 years pioneering translations in languages all over the Middle East and North Africa. He is most well-known for his work leading the Kitaab al Hayaat (Book of Life, NAV) Arabic translation. Over 30 million copies have been distributed.

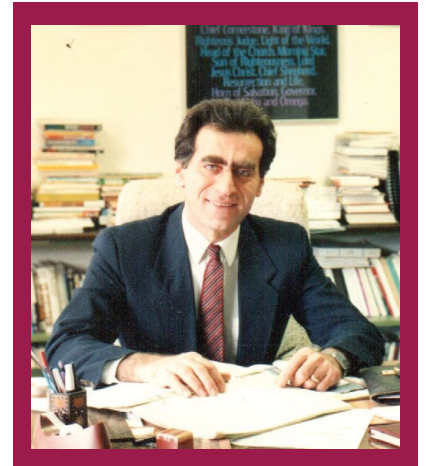

Drawing on his experience reaching international students in Beirut, Georges and his wife, Joy, began evangelizing on the campus of the University of Colorado, Boulder, with a focus on reaching Muslims. Using a strategy he called "The Nehemiah Network" he mobilized thousands of friendship partners from dozens of local churches.

INTERNSHIPS

Horizons offers semester-long discipleship and ministry internships in Boulder, Colorado, and Beirut, Lebanon.

Our International Student Ministry is dedicated to “Reaching the Nations at our Doorstep,” reaching over 18 major campuses in seven states.

Reaching the World at Our Doorstep

The ultimate goal of our International Student Ministries is to cultivate thriving groups of Christian internationals that are discipled and mentored to follow Jesus, and equipped to carry the gospel to the ends of the earth!

Events

Horizons hosts events and activities not only for students, but for international professionals and families in the community. Students are welcomed into a family-like atmosphere of cultural dinners, hikes, sports, and friendship programs to foster relationships with local Americans.

Bible Studies

Horizons hosts Bible studies to get American and international Christians and seekers together to study the Bible. Groups are available for seekers, as well as more advanced students of the Bible, and various language groups are encouraged.

ESL – English as a Second Language

We give internationals an opportunity to learn English in a Christian environment. Teachers build relationships with international students while helping them develop more confidence in their English skills.

THE WORK muslim ministry



Horizons shares the gospel with Muslims around the world. One of our busiest areas is the MENA (Middle East & North Africa) region. Right now, one in three people in Lebanon is a refugee. The ministry centers in Lebanon welcome over 1600 refugees through their doors each week!

Reaching Muslims in MENA and Beyond

What is happening now in the MENA (the Middle East and North Africa) region can be described as “the perfect storm.”

Seeds sown in the Muslim world in the early days of mission, combined with significant upheaval in the political and social landscape of the Middle East and North Africa, have resulted in record numbers of people who are open to hearing and accepting the gospel!

Since the beginning of 2013, Horizons' MENA team has seen over 1,400 proclamations of faith by Muslims, with over 800 of these that remained engaged in long-term discipleship relationships for more than 6 months. The team of 80 staff and interns has planted 5 ministry centers throughout Lebanon, as well as 4 ministry centers in the countries of Syria, Jordan and Turkey. Horizons collaborates with over 45 local churches in Lebanon and is mobilizing them for the harvest.

Strategic Guidance

Horizons helped catalyze and guide a church planting movement among Kurds in Iraq in the mid-90s, and a successful church-planting movement among Albanian Muslims in Kosovo since 1994, which resulted in **15,000 professions of faith and the establishment of over 40 churches.**

We believe that God has more good works prepared for Horizons to do (Eph. 2:10). We appreciate your prayers and support as we pursue the vast opportunities the Lord has provided.



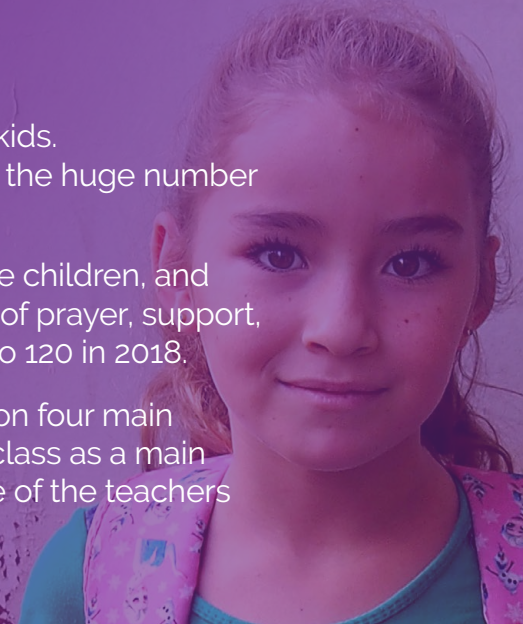

SCHOOL OF HOPE - BEIRUT, LEBANON

School of Hope was established by faith in 2014, and it started with 20 kids. Though we had no funding at the time, we had to do something about the huge number of refugee children – over 300,000 – who had no school to attend.

The purpose of the School of Hope is to make disciples among refugee children, and reach their parents with the gospel through the children. By the power of prayer, support, and encouragement, we now serve 100 students and aim to increase to 120 in 2018.

Children at School of Hope are taught the Syrian curriculum, focusing on four main subjects: Arabic, English, Math and Science, with the addition of Bible class as a main subject. Every student here is the fruit of the prayers and sacrificial love of the teachers throughout the school year. Keep these children in your prayers!

THE WORK *biblical missiology*



Horizons is committed to calling the global church back to a fully biblical approach in Bible translation, church planting, and evangelistic methods.

Biblical Missiology presents a positive approach to missions and directly challenges practices that do not honor God. Biblical Missiology also leads a global collaborative partnership of Christian leaders, converts from Islam, indigenous church leaders, missionaries, and theologians, to develop missions strategies that are both relevant and biblical.

Since 2009, *BiblicalMissiology.org* has become a significant voice among scholars, churches, and Christians who are seeking a gospel-oriented view on current missions trends and controversies. Horizons led the drive to protect the term "Son of God" in Bible translations, and collected 15,000 petition signatures from Christians around the world.

As a result, churches, organizations, and denominations have taken positions calling for biblically faithful approaches to Bible translation.

UNITED STATES

Horizons ministers to international students in 10 US locations. Staff, interns and volunteers are reaching out to thousands of international students on over 18 campuses. Cultural events, group activities, and friendship partner programs pair students with Christian families who show them the love of Christ and initiate gospel conversations.

BOULDER

The 777 Broadway Facility houses Horizons' US Headquarters and the International Crossroads Student House, which is home to 45 international students each year.

NORTH AFRICA

Horizons staff members run a language institute in one North African country, where they establish relationships with students with whom they share the gospel. Elsewhere in North Africa, Horizons sends indigenous missionaries from Lebanon to conduct discipleship seminars and 1-to-1 mentorship and counseling for dozens of converts from Islam.

KOSOVO

In 1994, Georges began training and encouraging three young believers, who began leading a small church plant among Albanian Muslims. Since then, the work has steadily grown and flourished, and now that tiny church has planted dozens of ministries around the country. Georges returns regularly to provide training to about 100 indigenous church leaders.

MIDDLE EAST

Since 2012, when Horizons established its first ministry center in Beirut, Lebanon. The team has grown rapidly and is now operating 9 ministry centers, reaching thousands of Muslims with the gospel each month. They disciple hundreds of converts from Islam, in partnership with a network of Lebanese Churches. Horizons Lebanon is also sending missionaries into surrounding countries to evangelize, disciple, and train.

HONG KONG

Horizons International Asia was established in 2015, and has been sending out both short- and long-term missionaries to Central Asia and the Middle East. Many teams and interns have been sent from Hong Kong to serve and be trained in Beirut. Horizons International Asia also trains and mobilizes local churches to reach out among Muslims in Hong Kong, and has invited Georges to speak in churches; conduct training seminars; conduct a Cubs to Lions discipleship event; and participate in debates and dialogues with Muslim leaders.

CHINA & MALAYSIA

In 2007, Horizons trained Pastor C, who then translated the Engaging Islam curriculum into Chinese. In 2009 he joined Horizons' staff and began teaching the curriculum in multiple provinces of China, as well as Malaysia. Since then he has trained thousands of Asian Bible school students to reach Muslims for Christ, and has established several Muslim evangelism teams in multiple locations, to make disciples among the 20+ million Muslims throughout China.

ZAMBIA

Since 1997, Horizons has been assisting Zambian churches to carry out the Great Commission among Muslims. André Houssney has led Horizons' efforts in Zambia, and has built several missional businesses in order to support the ministry locally and sustainably. The funds from these activities have supported the Zambian church to build a missions training center, send Zambian missionaries to Tanzania, and build churches and schools. Plans are underway for the first Zambian missionaries to serve in Lebanon in Spring 2018.

SOUTH AFRICA

In South Africa, Horizons staff are training and equipping churches to meet the challenge of Islam in their communities. Our staff in Cape Town conduct regular training in churches around the country, and are joined by Georges and others for special events, debates with Islamic leaders, and intensive teaching courses.

THE VISION 2018

Millions of Muslims are more open to the gospel than ever before. Horizons recognizes this and is responding with its full capacity, to raise up a new generation of faithful and fruitful disciples.

STRATEGIC PRIORITIES: 2018-2023

- 1) Build the capacity of the ministry centers and partner churches in Lebanon to disciple growing numbers of converts and train leaders to expand Horizons' regional impact.
- 2) Continue establishing ministries in three key North African countries (Tunisia, Algeria, and Morocco) and at least 3 other locations in the Middle East (particularly in Lebanon, Syria, Jordan, and Turkey).
- 3) Continue establishing International Student Ministries around the US and the world, in order to reach the nations at our doorstep for Christ.
- 4) Produce all of Horizons discipleship and evangelism training content in multi-media format (books, curricula, video, internet, social media) for maximum global impact and distribution.
- 5) Equip a group of international teachers to teach the Horizons curricula around the world, in order to train workers for the harvest and disciple converts from Islam.
- 6) Develop and send indigenous missionaries from Zambia, Hong Kong, Kosovo, and many other locations to carry out strategic ministry efforts globally.
- 7) Develop the ministry academies of the "Middle East Center for World Missions," (MECWM) and lay the groundwork for construction of the MECWM in Beirut, Lebanon, by developing detailed plans, raising significant start-up funds, and acquiring property in Northeast Beirut.

Vision

That the Church in the Middle East and North Africa would send out large numbers of indigenous missionaries to effectively and efficiently make disciples for Christ in their region and globally.

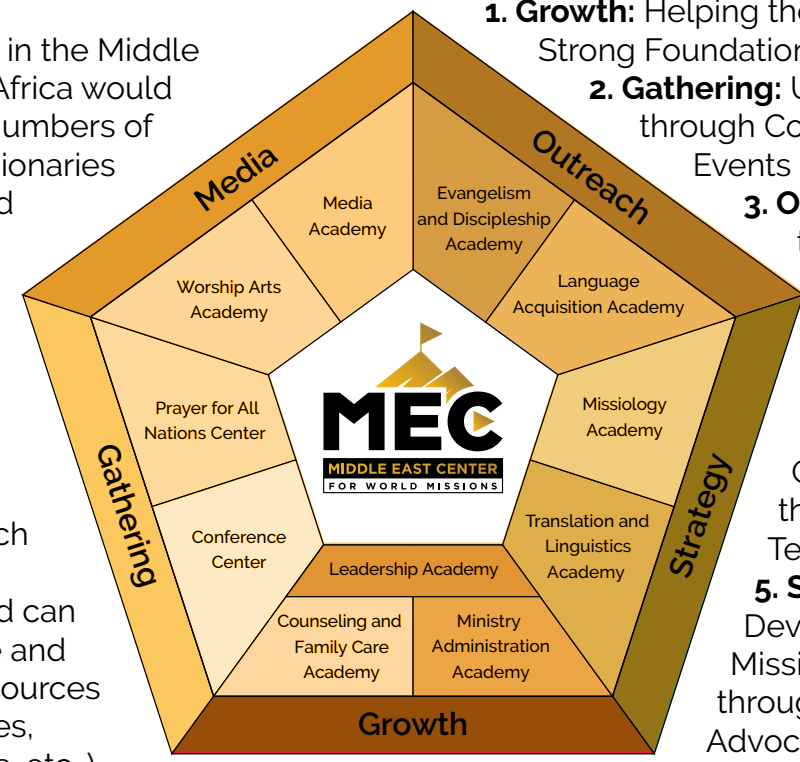
Strategy

To provide a platform on which believers from around the world can gather, combine and leverage the resources (human resources, training, finances, etc...) that are largely dormant in the churches in the Middle East.

Objective

To build a hub and network that facilitate the mobilization, training, and sending of missionaries from the Middle East and North Africa to the world. Our goal is to equip Christians from the Middle East and North Africa to go. Specifically, our long-term goal is to build the capacity of the MECWM to equip 220 long-term students annually, which is an average of ten Christians per year from each of

- 1. Growth:** Helping the Church Build a Strong Foundation
- 2. Gathering:** Unifying the Church through Corporate Prayer and Events
- 3. Outreach:** Training the Body of Christ in Evangelism, Discipleship, and Missions
- 4. Media:** Giving the Church a Global Voice through Arts and Technology
- 5. Strategy:** Developing Global Missions Strategy through Research and Advocacy



We look forward to sharing more updates on the **MECWM** in the coming months. We plan to kick off the MECWM campaign on January 1st, 2019 and if this gets you excited, start praying now about how you can get involved.

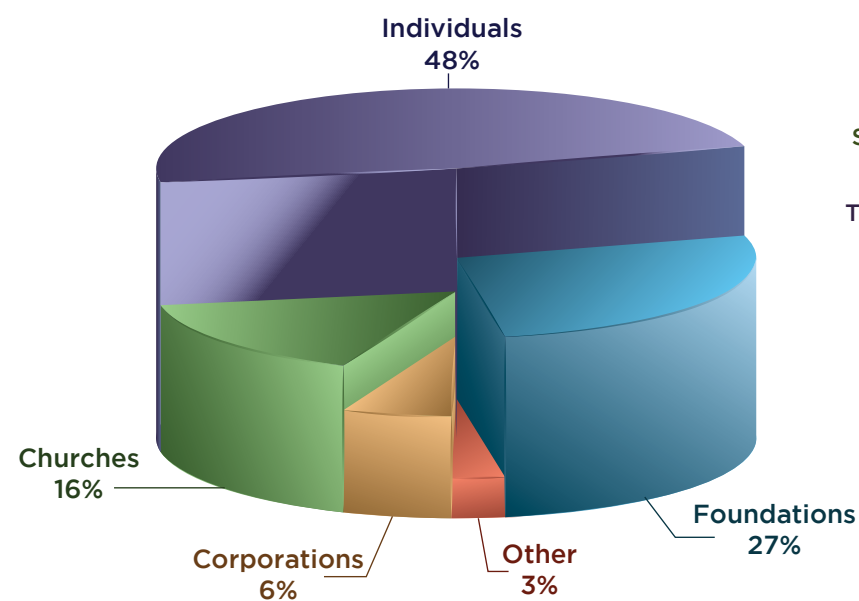

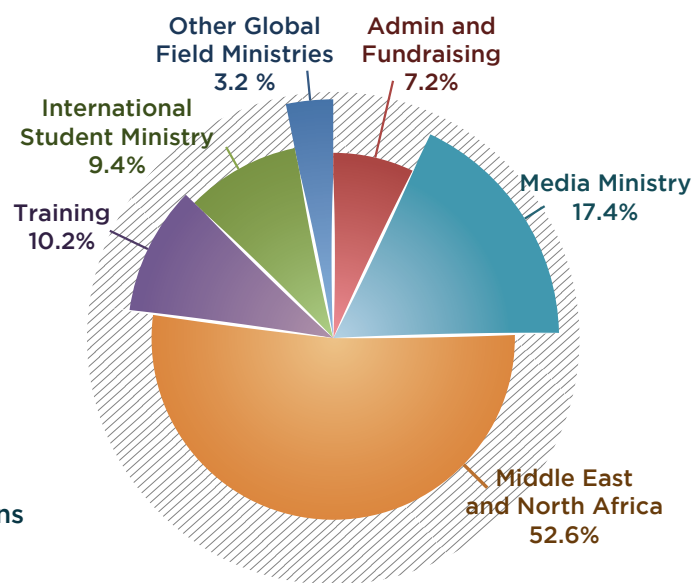
